Schedule

Day 1	Embark on your adventure at 8:00 AM in Labuan Bajo, where our crew will warmly welcome you and guide you to the harbor. After enjoying a refreshing welcome drink on board and settling into your cabin, we'll kick off the trip with a safety briefing and boat orientation. Afterwards we'll head to Central Komodo , ready to dive into three amazing dive sites. Central Komodo is known for its vibrant coral reefs, diverse marine life, a big variety of dive site topographies as well as its regular Manta Ray sightings due to a number of cleaning stations in the main channel of Komodo - get ready to go on your first of many Manta hunts! Whilst Komodo is famous for its exhilarating drift dives through powerful currents, Central Komodo also features a selection of more sheltered dive sites. These are perfect for easing you into the currents, ensuring you feel comfortable and confident as you explore Komodo's underwater world. The day finishes with a night dive in Siaba Besar, a beautiful underwater pinneacle with large coral formations that attract a large variety of macro life. As the day winds down, relax and enjoy your first sunset drink on board while we anchor for the night.
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Day 2	The day starts with a sunrise wakeup call, a light breakfast and a beautiful morning dive. After your main breakfast we explore three more dive sites in Central. Today, we'll visit some of Komodo's most iconic dive sites, including Batu Bolong and Tatawa Kecil , where you'll get acquainted the renowned Komodo currents. Experience the vibrant fish soup at Batu Bolong, often hailed as of the world's best dive spots, and marvel at the unique topography of Tatawa Kecil, which offers swim-throughs, drop-offs, boulders and many more. Both dive sites attract large fish who play in the current lines, adding an extra layer of excitement. In the afternoon we set sail south towards Padar Island, where we'll have another night dive before we anchor for the night.
Day 3	Experience the beauty of Padar Island on Day 3. After a light breakfast, we'll start into the day with a sunrise hike up to Padar's famous viewpoint to witness a breathtaking sunrise over Komodo. Throughout the day we have planned for three dives into the stunning dive sites around Padar. The dive sites are known for beautiful coral reefs and a variety of topographies, which attract lots of marine life. In the afternoon, unwind at Padar's beautiful Pink Beach, where the unique pink hue comes from the blend of broken red coral with white sand. We finish off the day with a night dive in Padar.
Day 4	Experience the thrill of diving in the South of Komodo National Park , where the waters are slightly colder but rich in nutrients, attracting a diverse array of life. With fewer crowds than in Central Komodo, you'll have ample time to explore the large and vibrant coral formations over three exhilarating dives. At least one of these dives will take you to the iconic Manta Alley , renowned for its frequent high-density manta ray encounters and breathtaking underwater scenery.
Day 5	On your final full day aboard, we'll kick off with two invigorating morning dives in the South . Afterwards we drive east to Nusa Kode , a small island south of Rinca, where we will enjoy another dive. Late afternoon we'll set out to encounter the legendary Komodo Dragon on Rinca Island , the largest living lizard in the world, found only in select areas of Komodo National Park. A must-do on your Komodo bucket list! As the South of Komodo is less touristic and the dragons are less exposed to tourism, we'll observe these magnificent creatures from the safety of our speedboat. As the day draws a close, relax on Sangeang's sun beds or take one last swim in the crystal-clear waters, before we gather for a special farewell dinner on the deck of Sangeang as you take in your final Komodo sunset.
Day 6	Early morning we set sail towards Labuan Bajo, where we arrive for a final breakfast on the boat. It's time to say farewell to your dive buddies and our dedicated crew, cherishing the unforgettable memories from your Komodo adventure. After disembarking at the harbor around 10:00 AM, we're here to assist guests with transportation to Komodo Airport or your hotel.
